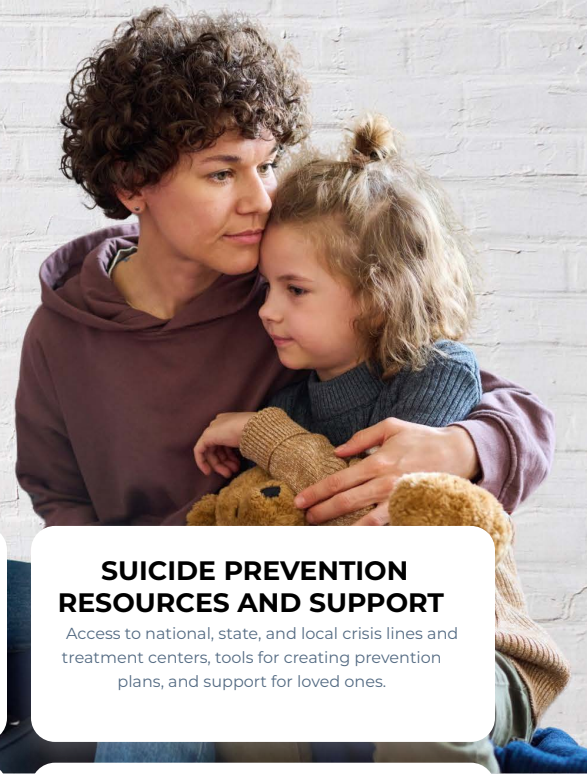


For Homeless Resources

SERVICE DIRECTORY

Comprehensive index of local, state, and national organizations working to solve homelessness and its ancillary concerns, categorized by topic.

CLOTHING AND HYGIENE ASSISTANCE

Interactive tool allowing users to locate free or low-cost items in their area.

SUICIDE PREVENTION RESOURCES AND SUPPORT

Access to national, state, and local crisis lines and treatment centers, tools for creating prevention plans, and support for loved ones.

REFERRAL APPLICATION

Online application that can include assessments, tracking, and full integration with your Network of Care personalized content.

HOUSING ASSESSMENT AND RESOURCES

Guided search for unhoused persons, their loved ones, and outreach/case managers to identify needs and provide local options.

HEALTH CENTERS

Searchable, statewide list of centers that provide primary healthcare services to persons with limited access to medical care.

Network of Care is recognized by SAMHSA as a qualified expenditure in its recent guidelines for the American Rescue Plan's \$1.5 billion Mental Health Block Grant (MHBG) appropriation.

In this four-year grant, SAMHSA explicitly encourages states to use MHBG funding for infrastructure development, as long as the intent of the infrastructure supports or benefits persons with serious mental illness or severe emotional disturbance (SMI-SED). The Network of Care assists persons with SMI-SED in finding treatment, support, awareness, education and other resources necessary for recovery.

- Unlimited local content to personalize and publish articles, resources, and tools that directly relate to your community's needs.
- Practitioner Search that provides contact details and information about doctors and clinicians by ZIP code.
- Opioid Crisis resources for general opioid information, including education and harm reduction techniques.
- Interactive maps displaying locations and service details of Naloxone-prescribing pharmacies, needle exchange, and safe drug-disposal sites throughout the state.
- Comprehensive Health Library that assembles more than 30,000 high-quality articles, fact sheets, and interactive tools on more than 4,000 physical- and mental-health topics.
- Universal account creation access for content personalization, personal health records, emergency care cards, health directives, and more.
- Extensive crisis and emergency resources at the federal, state, and local level.
- All websites are ADA Section 508-compliant, with ability for content to be translated into 117 languages.
